Apply for the New Joint Master in European Politics and Society (EPS)

A unique study programme offers courses at four major European Universities for those who are interested in Europe in the global world.

Do you want to acquire ability to see beyond boundaries between disciplines as well as those between states and of the European Union and be prepared for the international job market as future manager, policymaker or research leader who can operate at a European level and is able to build bridges within Europe and with countries outside?

What do we offer?

Charles University together with its international academic partners is offering a unique new two-year international joint-master in European Politics and Society (EPS) in which you can study at four major European research universities in four beautiful cities: Prague, Leiden, Krakow and Barcelona.

This programme is linking the fields of European politics, contemporary history and culture, economics, international relations and policymaking. The key role of the programme is to identify and analyse the key challenges Europe faces today (migration, security, populism, (Br)exits), and prepare the next generation of managers, policymakers and research leaders to deal with them.

Programme structure

In the first semester of the EPS Programme (in Prague) you are introduced to the key challenges, the second semester focuses on EU related courses (in Krakow or Leiden). In the third and fourth semesters, the programme offers four different study tracks reflecting the diverse expertise of the Consortium members: *Traditions and Future of a Multi-level Europe* in Prague, *Centre and Periphery* in Krakow, *Maintaining a Leading Role for Europe in the World* in Leiden, and *The Future of the EU, Ever Growing or Falling Apart?* Each track combines various elective courses, research methods training, an internship and language tuition with an advanced research dissertation supervised by key staff from each Partner University.

Extra-curricular training and link to the work field

Two important features of this exclusive programme are an intensive extra-curricular training programme and a direct link to the future work field through frequent interaction with professionals and experts from outside academia through the Associate Partners of the programme. These partners include businesses like Samsung, international organisations like TEPSA, UNESCO and Fórum 2000.

Joint events

All students spent their first semester in Prague, where they participate in the **Prague Introductory week**, meeting the academic coordinators and some faculty staff of all universities involved and where they are introduced to the programme and the city. At the end of the first semester, you choose the topic of your Master thesis and write a draft proposal for the thesis project, which you will present at a three-day **Research Seminar in Barcelona**.

For the second semester students have two options, go to Leiden or Krakow, where you focus on the functioning of the EU and begin your specialisation through a series of optional courses. The two final semesters can be spent at any of the four universities depending on your specialisation. In the third semester all students will also travel to Brussels, for the **Brussels field trip**, a 3-day event to meet experts from EU institutions, think tanks and other relevant organizations who will also discuss the thesis topic with you. Part of the third semester is an obligatory internship at an Associate Partner of the programme.

After the third semester all students will again participate in the **Barcelona Research Seminar** where you will get feedback on your thesis project from all other students and academic experts. The final semester is devoted to finalising the Master thesis, but all students will also participate in the **Oxford Spring School**. Thanks to the partnership with, you will be able to experience this unique event and academic experience, where you can debate and have your ideas and research scrutinised by fellow students and academics from other Europaeum members.

Tuition fees

Tuition fees are **8000 EUR per year**. This programme has applied for the **Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree**. Full EMJMD Scholarships are expected for 20 students from Autumn 2017.

Excellence Scholarship Award: Two best self-funded students from the first year per each intake will be awarded by the 'Excellence Scholarship Award' (covers 50% of the Tuition Fee for the second year of their study).

Fee waiver of 20% will be available for students from the European Economic Area (EEA) countries.

Application

The regular deadline for academic year 2017/18 is **30th April 2017**. You can apply on-line here: <http://fsveng.fsv.cuni.cz/FSVEN-498.html>

All applications must include the following:

- Copy of a diploma to show completed Bachelor's or Master's studies, or confirmation of ongoing studies in the academic year that those studies will be completed.
- Copy of a second diploma (second completed Bachelor's or High School diploma)
- Transcripts of marks and academic results from both of the previous studies
- CV
- Motivation letter
- 2 letters of recommendation
- Completed supplementary questionnaire indicating study track preferences
